Worbla's Deco Art - the unbelievable versatile thermoplastic modelling and moulding pearls with almost no shrinking at all after cooling-down from the Worbla's Art Series!

It is activated by heat (> 65 °C / >149 °F), stiffened after 10 minutes but can be reactivated at any time plus it is very easy to handle:

Put the little pearls into a metal wire and dip them into hot water. As soon as the material becomes lucent it is ready to work with.

Now e.g. you can mould them into a form, roll and mill the mass for getting a plate or model it free-handed. In addition you can simply use it for evening edges plus Worbla's Finest Art's surfaces.

Acrylic, spray-paint or permanent markers can be used for coloring its surface. Using acrylic you can even dye the material itself: Just put on some latex gloves, admix the color with the activated pellets and wait until it's hardened plus some more minutes.

Afterwards you can re-activate and use it without any mess because the acrylic stays in the material!

The pics shown here are just giving a tiny impression of all the possibilities using Worbla's Deco Art, just as you can combine it easily e.g. for ornaments with our well-known Worbla's Finest Art.
